The recruitment process will then be as follows:

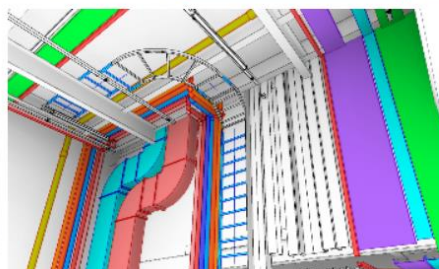
- On receipt of sending your CV we will invite you for an interview and to complete an aptitude test
